

Preface

The Workshop on “Existence, Regularity and A Priori Bounds for Differential Problems” on the occasion of the 70th birthday of Mario Marino was held on May 3-4, 2013, at the Department of Mathematics and Computer Science of the University of Catania.

This issue of the *Bollettino dell’Accademia Gioenia* collects six contributions coming from the plenary lectures of the invited speakers, who are long-standing colleagues and friends of Mario Marino: Angelo Alvino, Orazio Arena, Joachim Naumann, Giovanni Porru, Giorgio Talenti, and Antonio Tarsia.

The closing article is the last academic lecture of Mario Marino, held on June 12, 2013. It is a short history of the academicians that held the chair of Mathematical Analysis at the University of Catania during the 150 years of unified Italy.

Mario Marino, member of the *Accademia Gioenia* of Catania, has been full professor of Mathematical Analysis at the University of Catania for almost forty years. In his research he deals mainly with existence, uniqueness and regularity of solutions to partial differential equations and systems of elliptic and parabolic type.
